**IF YOUR TREAD DEPTH IS LOWER
THAN THE RIM OF A 20p COIN,
BETTER GET YOUR TYRES CHECKED**



Inserting a 20p coin into a tyre's tread depth to check if the rim of the coin is covered by the tread gives a good indication as to whether your tyres are still safe and legal. If you can see the rim, the tyres may be worn below the legal minimum of 1.6mm of tread and will soon need replacing.

Braking in the wet on tyres with low tread will require a much longer stopping distance, putting the driver, passengers and other road users at risk.

Motorists found to be driving on illegal tyres face a maximum penalty of three penalty points and a fine of up to £2,500 per tyre.
