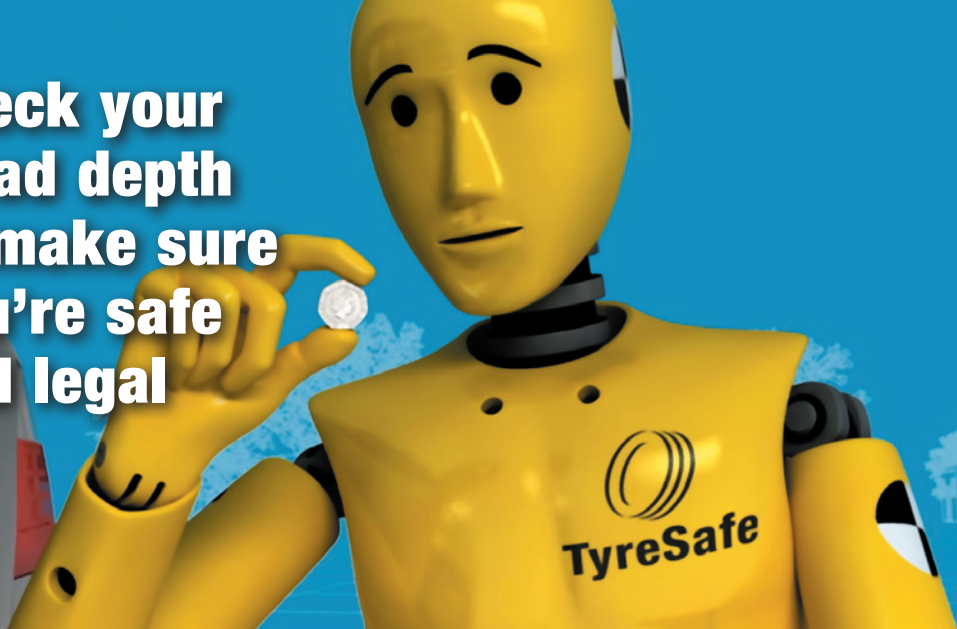

TyreSafe



Check your tread depth to make sure you're safe and legal



Using a 20 pence piece you can quickly and easily check whether your tyre tread depths are safe and legal. This keeps you and your passengers safe on the roads.

Simply insert a 20p coin into your tyre's main tread grooves to see if the outer rim of the coin is covered by the tread. Repeat this in all the main grooves and at several points around its circumference. If you can see the rim of the coin when it is inserted at any point, your tyre may be illegal and should be checked by a tyre specialist.

Your tyres' condition is critical for acceleration, braking, steering and cornering and as the driver, you are responsible for making sure tyres are legal and roadworthy.

Failure to comply with the legal minimum standards can result in fines of up to £2,500 and 3 penalty points – for each illegal tyre. UK law requires car tyres to have a minimum of 1.6mm of tread across the central three quarters of the tyre around its entire circumference.

Tyres have a tread depth well above the legal limit.



Tread depth may be below the legal limit. If stopped by police, you could face a maximum of three penalty points and a fine of up to £2,500 per tyre.
